- Current inpatient census is 7 (5 are active COVID)
- Tested 102 people so far this week

AMIE HOLT CARE CENTER

- No residents have COVID
- Unfortunately, residents returned to isolation on 11/12/20 due to an asymptomatic direct caregiver testing positive
- Additional admissions to AHCC from the hospital are planned for next week

CONSTRUCTION

- The first new air handler will be installed on the clinic roof on Sunday 11/15/20
- Interior ceiling work continues throughout the building

CDC HOLIDAY COVID GUIDELINES

- Check community levels and status before traveling
- Consider exposure risk during travel (airports, bus stations, trains stations, public transport, gas stations and rest stops all pose greater risk)
- Location of gathering outdoor spaces are better than indoor spaces with poor ventilation
- Duration of gathering Avoid being within 6 feet of others for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more
- Number and crowding of people at gathering
- Behaviors of attendees prior to gathering
- Behavior of attendees at gathering
