

**AMENDED REGULATIONS
MIKESSELL/POTTS RECREATION AREA
LAKE DE SMET, JOHNSON COUNTY, WYOMING**

Section One

Title

The title of these regulations shall be the Mikesell/Potts Regulations.

Section Two

Authority

These regulations are adopted and amended pursuant to the authority set forth in Wyoming Statute § 18-9-201 and promulgated as provided by the Wyoming Administrative Procedures Act, Wyoming Statutes § 16-3-101 et seq.

Section Three

Purpose

The purpose of the Mikesell/Potts Regulations is to conserve peace and order and preserve the property located within the recreational area.

Section Four

Inspection of Regulations

These rules shall be of public record and shall be available for inspection in the office of the Board of County Commissioners.

Section Five

Offenses and Definitions

Section 5A – Daily Camping Permit - Daily camping permits shall be required for all overnight camping, which includes, but is not limited to: camping trailers, RV's, tents and motor vehicles. A current camping permit must be prominently displayed in the window or door entrance.

Section 5B – Camping Limitation - No party shall camp within the Mikesell/Potts Recreation Area for a period of longer than fourteen (14) consecutive days.

Section 5C – Vandalism/Destruction of Property - No person shall deface, injure or destroy property of another, or aid and abet in the defacement, injury or destruction of property of another.

Section 5D – Explosives and Projectiles - No persons shall discharge any fireworks, firearm, BB gun, pellet gun, slingshot, bow, crossbow or other projectile object within or across the Mikesell/Potts Recreation Area.

Section 5E – Breach of Peace - It is the intent of these regulations to establish a quiet time between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.. No person shall run generators, or engage in loud or boisterous activities between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

No person shall disturb the peace of the recreation area at any time by using threatening, abusive or obscene language or violent actions, or create any noise or disturbance within the Mikesell/Potts recreation area so as to disturb the peace of other visitors.

Section 5F – Speed Limit - The speed limit for the operation of motor and propelled vehicles within the Mikesell/Potts Recreation area shall be ten (10) miles per hour.

Section 5G – Operators Licenses - No person shall operate a motor vehicle within the Mikesell/Potts Recreation Area unless he/she is currently licensed in conformity with Wyoming Statute for the type of vehicle being operated. No vehicle shall be operated within the Mikesell/Potts Recreation Area unless the vehicle is registered in conformity with Wyoming Statute.

Section 5H – Off Road Use Prohibited - No person shall operate a motor vehicle in areas within the Mikesell/Potts Recreation Area other than on constructed roads or parking areas.

Section 5I – Littering Prohibited - Littering within the Mikesell/Potts Recreation Area is prohibited. A person is guilty of littering he places, throws, scatters or deposits any garbage, debris, refuse or waste material, object or substances, including abandoned or junk vehicles or parts, within the Mikesell/Potts Recreation Area.

Section 5J – Dogs Required to be on Leash - Dogs are to be maintained on a leash at all times. The owner of a dog and any person charged with the care or control of a dog, shall ensure the dog is on a leash at all times while within the Mikesell/Potts Recreation Area.

Section 5K – Definitions - As used in these regulations:

- a. “Party” means a person or group of persons.
- b. “Camp” means to occupy physically or by the placement of personal property, a site at the Mikesell/Potts Recreation Area.

- c. "Motor Vehicle" shall have the same meaning as defined in Wyoming Statute § 31-1-101(a)(xv).
- d. "Property" means any public property located on the Mikesell/Potts Recreation area, including all trees, shrubs, buildings, fences, etc.
- e. "Recreation Area" means the Mikesell/Potts Recreation Area.

Section Six

Penalties

With the exception of Section 5F, a person convicted of violating the provisions of the Mikesell/Potts Regulations, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both.

A person convicted of violating Section 5F of the Mikesell/Potts Regulations shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and fined fifty dollars (\$50.00) plus two dollars (\$2.00) for every mile per hour over ten (10) miles per hour.
