


DESCRIPTION

of YOUNG Addition and of YOUNG SECOND Addition  
to the Townsite of the Village of Kaycee, Wyoming,  
as recorded in the Office of the County Clerk  
and Ex-Officio Register of Deed of Johnson County  
Wyoming, in Book No 19 of Deeds, on Page 248.  
wherein Richard Young Deeds to W.H.Zindel a  
one half interest in the above named Additions.

Beginning at the NE corner of the SE<sup>1/4</sup> of the  
NE<sup>1/4</sup> of Section 12, T. 43 N., R. 82 W. of the 6<sup>th</sup>  
PM, as located by J.B. Parker on January 13<sup>th</sup>  
1902 this point known as Station 1; running  
thence west 701.4 feet to the NE corner of  
the Kaycee Townsite known as Station No 2;  
thence running south 793 feet along the east  
line of Kaycee Townsite to station No 8; running  
thence East 376 feet to station No 9; running  
thence North 50 feet to station No 10; running  
thence East 325.4 feet to station No 11; running  
thence North 693 feet to point of beginning; also  
a strip as follows.

Commencing at the SE corner of Kaycee Town-  
site known as station No 3; running thence  
West 618.6 feet to station No 4; (also the south  
west corner of Kaycee Townsite); running thence  
South 50 feet to station No 6; running thence  
East 618.6 feet to station No 7; running thence  
North 50 feet to the point of beginning; both  
tracts containing in all, 12.3 Acres in the SE<sup>1/4</sup>  
of the NE<sup>1/4</sup> of section 12, T. 43 N., R. 82 W.,  
dated January 24<sup>th</sup> 1916.

I, Clyde R Wood of Buffalo Wyoming hereby Certify that this map was made  
from such records as are available in the Office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio  
Register of Deeds of Johnson County Wyoming. The original map of the YOUNG ADDI-  
TION and of the YOUNG SECOND ADDITION, having been lost, such records consist  
of the following; First, Receiving Book "C" shows that on January 27<sup>th</sup> 1917, Instr-  
ument No 20813, Edwin Burritt filed a Plat of the Young Addition and the Gran-  
tors are shown as W.H.Zindel and Richard Young while the Grantee is the Public;  
Second, Book No 19 of deeds on Page 248 shows a deed which describes  
the Young Addition and the Young Second Addition said description being  
shown in detail elsewhere on this map.

Third, the official plat of the Buell Addition to Kaycee Wyoming as survey-  
ed and mapped by Edwin Burritt also shows thereon a detailed map of the  
Young Addition and of the Young Second Addition, both of which are in accorda-  
nce with this map and the description here on and I hereby certify that  
this map is correct only in so far as the above listed records are correct.

Note: The North distance of 693 feet as shown on the east boundary of  
the YOUNG ADDITION is apparently an error as this distance should be 743  
feet.
