John Nolan of Kaycee, Johnson County, Wyoming, being the sole and absolute owner in fee simple of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of section 12 of Township 43, North of Range 82, West, for the purpose of laying out the townsite of the village of Kaycee in said County upon a portion of the above described lands, and having caused the same to be surveyed and platted by J. Brown Parker a Civil Engineer of said County, do hereby make and constitute this the official plat of said townsite of Kaycee, embracing the following described tract of land to-wit: Commencing at the NE corner of Sec. 12, Township 43 N. of Range 82 W. of the 6th P.M. running thence S. on a variation of 16° 35' E., on the E. line of sec. 12, a distance of 1320 feet to the N. E. Cor. of SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 12 Twp. 43 N. Range 82 W. designated as Sta. 1, on this plat, Thence W 701.4 ft. to the N.E. Cor. of Kaycee Townsite, designated as Sta. 2, thence S. 868 ft. to the S.E. Cor. of Kaycee Townsite, designated as Sta. 3, thence W. 618.6 ft. to S.W. Cor. of Kaycee Townsite, designated as Sta. 4, thence N. 868 ft. to N.W. Cor. of Kaycee Townsite, designated as Sta. 5, thence E. 618.6 ft. to N.E. Cor. of Kaycee Townsite, returning to Sta. 2.

The above and foregoing subdivision of the land herein described, as appears on this plat, is with the free & voluntary consent and in accordance with the desires of the undersigned owner and proprietor.
