"NOTE"
 THE NORTH LINE OF THE STEVEN B. SMITH TRACT OF LAND WAS DESCRIBED AS THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THE WYOMING RAILWAY. THIS LINE HAS BEEN OBLITERATED BY THE CITY'S MAIN SEWER TRUNK LINE AND LEVELING WORK DONE BY THE COUNTY OF JOHNSON. THE CITY OF BUFFALO SURVEYED A FOOT PATH IN 1988 AND THIS SURVEY FOLLOWS GENERALLY THE CENTER OF THE ORIGINAL RAILWAY. THIS SURVEY IS BASED ON THE PREMISE THAT THE FOOT PATH FOLLOWS THE GENERAL DIRECTION AND ALIGNMENT OF THE OLD RAILWAY.
