A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN INDUSTRIAL ROAD APPLICATION TO THE WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNING BODY FOR JOHNSON COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF SAFETY UPGRADES ON TW ROAD (CR #204) IN JOHNSON COUNTY

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Johnson County, Wyoming is experiencing heavy industrial traffic on TW Road (CR #204) from agricultural, mineral extraction, and other businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body for Johnson County desires to participate in the INDUSTRIAL ROAD PROJECT to assist in financing this project; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Johnson County recognized the need for the project; and

WHEREAS, the INDUSTRIAL ROAD PROJECT requires that certain criteria be met, as described in the Wyoming Department of Transportation Operating Policy Manual governing the program, and to the best of our knowledge this application meets those criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Johnson County plans to match the requested INDUSTRIAL ROAD PROJECT from general county road funds and county road funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY of Johnson County, that a grant application in the amount of \$2,000,000 be submitted to the Wyoming Department of Transportation for consideration;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Johnson County Road and Bridge Supervisor Scott Pehringer is hereby designated as the authorized representative of Johnson County to act on behalf of the Governing Body on all matters relating to this grant application.
