

Joint Powers Meeting
Minutes
January 16, 2018

A meeting of the Buffalo – Johnson Joint Powers Board Justice Center was brought to order at 1:25 p.m. on January 16, 2018 by Vice Chair Greenough in the Johnson County Commissioners Office. Those in attendance were: Commissioner Robert Perry, City Councilman Wes Haskins, and Clerk of District Court Deb Vandel. Also in attendance were: Buffalo Police Chief Jason Carder, Johnson County Sheriff Steve Kozisek, County Clerk Vicki Edelman and Sheila Newcomb, Commissioner's Assistant.

The minutes of the October 17, 2017 meeting were reviewed. Commissioner Perry moved and City Councilman Haskins seconded to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

The financial reports were reviewed. The balance in the checking totals \$39,488.82 and the CD totals \$12,831.17. The grand total is \$52,319.99. Three items needed board approval interest income in the amount of \$8.15 and a bill to Venture Technologies in the amount of \$9,400.00. Commissioner Perry moved and Clerk of District Court Vandel seconded to approve the financials. Motion carried.

Sheriff Kozisek said that the vestibule on the back step needs to be finished. And all the cameras are working properly.

With no further business to come before the board Commissioner Perry moved and City Councilman Haskins seconded to adjourn the meeting at 1:30 p.m. Motion carried.
