

Joint Powers Meeting
Minutes
April 17, 2018

A meeting of the Buffalo – Johnson Joint Powers Board Justice Center was brought to order at 1:30 p.m. on January 16, 2018 by Chairman Novotny in the Johnson County Commissioners Office. Those in attendance were: Commissioner Greenough, Commissioner Perry, Clerk of District Court Deb Vandel and Mayor Johnson. Also in attendance were: Buffalo Police Chief Jason Carder, Johnson County Sheriff Steve Kozisek, County Clerk Vicki Edelman, Civil Deputy County Attorney Barry Crago and Sheila Newcomb, Commissioner's Assistant.

The minutes of the January 16, 2018 meeting were reviewed. Mayor Johnson moved and Commissioner Greenough seconded to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

The financial reports were reviewed. The balance in the checking totals \$39,500.64 and the CD totals \$12,831.17. The grand total is \$52,331.81. Interest income in the amount of \$11.82 received board approval. Commissioner Perry moved and Mayor Johnson seconded to approve the financials. Motion carried.

Sheriff Kozisek said that the vestibule on the back step still needs to be finished. Deb Vandel said that the carpet tiles that were stained have been replaced. The Facilities Manager is looking into the ant and box elder problem in the County Attorney's office. The concrete pad at the Justice Center needs to be grinded down to rid it of slick spots. They will have Romine Construction to look into it.

The City of Buffalo will place \$15,000 in the Justice Center JPB budget and the Johnson County Commissioners will place \$15,000 in the Justice Center JPB budget.

With no further business to come before the board Commissioner Greenough moved and Mayor Johnson seconded to adjourn the meeting at 1:40 p.m. Motion carried.
