

Mountain Plains Heritage Park board meet on July 18, 2018, at the Johnson County Library with the following members in attendance: Christy Kessler, Megan Boggs, Vicky Gearhart and George Korhel. The meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm by President Christy Kessler.

Minutes from the June 16, 2018, was reviewed with no corrections or additions.

Treasurer's report was reviewed. A bill was paid to Roxie Turk for repair to lawn mower and Toro trimmer. George submitted a bill for gasoline for the mower. Megan made a motion to pay the bill and Vicky seconded.

Following correspondence was received: Local Government Liability Pool Declaration Page for July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019, F-32 Survey of Local Government Finances Form that needs to be submitted by September 30, 2018 and appointment letter from Commissioners for George Korhel to the MPHP Board.

Christy met with Dave Shaffer from Rocky Mountain Power on July 11, 2018, to sign the proposed 20' wide power line easement for Heritage Park. \$500.00 was received for this easement.

Bret Markovsky repaired the cabin chinking and advised that if the Heritage Park would purchase the stain for the new boards that he had placed in 2017 he would stain them. George advised he would do some checking and get some stain samples to look at.

Back Country Spraying sprayed both park trails for weeds on July 18, 2018.

Vicky contacted Les Hook with the City of Buffalo and requested water delivered at the upper park for the drip system for the trees. He advised they would bring water for July, August and September. Board members thank the City of Buffalo for this.

Megan advised the preliminary budget had been sent in. The final will be sent by July 31st.

The next board meeting will be held on August 15th at 4:30 p.m. at the Johnson County Library.

With no further business the meeting was adjourned at 5:05 p.m.
