

# Johnson County Ambulance Rural Health Care District

## Minutes

October 9, 2018

The regular monthly meeting of the Johnson County Ambulance Rural Health Care District was held at the Ambulance Office, Buffalo, Wyoming on Tuesday, October 9, 2018. The meeting began at 7:07 a.m. The meeting was called to order by Bob McBride. Present were: Dozier Tabb, Marilyn Connolly, Bob McBride, Luke Goddard, Commissioner Bill Novotny, Robert Garrison, Carmen Christian, Jen Hicks, Jim Hicks, Michelle Chapman, Dave Harness and Jill Wright.

**I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF LAST MEETING:**

The motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting on September 11th was made by Dozier Tabb and seconded by Luke Goddard. Approved by all.

**II. VIEW AND APPROVE TREASURER'S REPORT:**

Dozier Tabb presented the September Treasurer's Report for review. Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report was made by Luke Goddard and seconded by Marilyn Connolly. Approved by all.

**III. BUFFALO REPORT:**

**1. Ambulance Calls**

Dave reported September had 72 ambulance calls consisting of the following: 53 medical and 19 trauma; 16 were transfers, 2 nurse transfers, 1 canceled, 16 patient refusals, 10 standbys, 1 DOA, 1 code, 0 extrication, and 0 trauma team activations. 46 in-town calls and 26 out-of-town calls. 59 were Johnson county residents and 13 non-residents.

**2. AEMT Course**

Dave informed the Board the AEMT Course offered by Rocky Mountain Ambulance has not yet begun.

**IV. KAYCEE REPORT:**

**1. Ambulance Calls**

Michelle reported there were 7 runs in August: 2 medical, 0 trauma, 6 refusals, 1 transport and 2 standbys.

**2. MCI**

Michelle reported that the full-scale MCI training went well from an EMS standpoint, they learned a lot and it was beneficial.

V. **OLD BUSINESS:**

1. **DigeTekS**

Marilyn Connolly reported that she had not heard form DigeTekS regarding their report.

2. **AG Opinion**

Tucker Ruby reported that he had received the AG report and was not going to go into detail regarding its contents, as each concerned party also received the opinion. He suggested that the board use the AG opinion as a guide as they go forward, and if either party feels that should move forward he hoped that both parties' representatives would meet with him prior to pursuing any other course of action.

Dozier Tabb said that he is seeing advances in medicine that suggest that these intercepts will be beneficial. Luke Goddard stated that he is not always a fan of airplane usage, as it's expensive and the companies are overly aggressive. He requested that we not have LZ's within a 20-mile radius of a hospital.
