Remarks: Lake DeSmet had no releases with both the North and South dam shut off. Healy Reservoir continued diverting water from Clear Creek, until shutting down the inlet gates on December 23rd for the winter. Shell Creek continued to have flows enter Lake DeSmet, filling 124 AF. While there was some precipitation late around the Holidays, most of the month of December experienced dry and above freezing conditions, which contributed to higher than typical evaporation losses.
