

Commissioner Meeting May 21, 2019

The regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was brought to order by Chairman William J Novotny, III at 9:00am on Tuesday May 21, 2019. Attending were Commissioners Linda Greenough and Robert Perry, Commissioner's Assistant Sheila Newcomb, County Clerk Vicki Edelman and Deputy County Attorney Barry Crago.

Perry moved to approve the minutes of the May 7, 2019 regular meeting. Greenough seconded, motion carried.

Charlie Augello from Inside Inc/T-Mobile and Marilyn Connolly met with the Commissioners to discuss renting space on the Fort Street tower. After discussion with the radio user groups Marilyn will report back to the Commission.

Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the VOA contracts which have been approved by County Attorney Tucker Ruby. Perry seconded, motion carried.

Perry moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the Cooperative Law Enforcement Agreement between the Johnson County Sheriff's Office and the USDA Forest Service/Big Horn National Forest for extra patrol. Greenough seconded, motion carried.

Perry moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the MOU between Johnson County and the City of Cheyenne for Law Enforcement Extraterritorial Assistance. Greenough seconded, motion carried.

Greenough moved to approve the TANFF Grant in the amount of \$52,500 for the 19-20FY. Perry seconded, motion carried.

Perry moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the Contract between Wy Dept of Health, Behavioral Health Division and Johnson County Commissioners for the Supervised Alternative Treatment Program. Greenough seconded, motion carried.


Greenough moved to approve the TANFF Grant in the amount of \$52,500 for the 19-20FY. Perry seconded, motion carried.


