

Commissioner Meeting June 4, 2019

The regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was brought to order by Chairman, William J Novotny, III at 9:00am on Tuesday June 4, 2019. Attending were Commissioners Linda Greenough and Robert Perry, Commissioner's Assistant Sheila Newcomb, County Clerk Vicki Edelman and Deputy County Attorney Barry Crago.

Perry moved to approve the minutes of the May 21, 2019 regular meeting. Greenough seconded, motion carried.

Greenough moved to approve the appointment of Kimberly Harvey and Margaret Smith to the Library Board for 3-year terms. Perry seconded, motion carried.

Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the catering permit to Lake Stop Resort for the Williams wedding reception @Lakeview Lodge 307 on 6/15/19 and the Malt Beverage permit to South Fork Lodge for the pig wrestling fundraiser on 6/29/19 @ the Johnson County Fairgrounds. Perry seconded, motion carried.

Perry moved to approve the vouchers for May in the amount of \$206,881.00. Greenough seconded, motion carried.

Perry moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the Annual Contribution Agreement between the University of Wyoming Extension and Johnson County for the 4-H Coordinator in the amount of \$24,438.00. Greenough seconded, motion carried.

Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the Contract for Services between Johnson County and the Town of Kaycee for facilities management of Harold Jarrard Park. Perry seconded, motion carried.

Anita Bartlett with Powder River Conservation District, Allison McKenzie with NRCS and Zach Byram with Clear Creek Conservation District met with the Commissioners to give updates on high water issues in Johnson County. After some discussion Greenough moved to approve a letter of support and sponsorship for any EWP projects for both conservation districts in Johnson County. Perry seconded, motion carried.

Other items discussed were the fuel bid for Johnson County, board vacancies for HJP and Jim Gatchell Museum and road damage from high water.
