Minutes

March 10, 2020

The regular monthly meeting of the Johnson County Rural Health Care District was held at the Johnson County Planning Office, Buffalo, Wyoming on Tuesday, March 10, 2020. The meeting began at 7:02 a.m. The meeting was called to order by President Marilyn Connolly. Present were Marilyn Connolly, Bob McBride, Mark Haines, Jim Hicks, Jeff Cope, Shawn Sullivan, Jill Wright, Michelle Chapman, Mark Bentley, Dave Harness and Karri White. A quorum was present.

I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF LAST MEETING:

The motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting on February 11th was made by Bob McBride. Seconded by Jim Hicks. Approved by all.

II. VIEW AND APPROVE TREASURER'S REPORT:

Jim Hicks presented the February Treasurer's Report for review. Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report was made by Bob McBride and seconded by Jim Hicks. Approved by all.

III. BUFFALO REPORT:

1. Ambulance Calls

Dave reported February had 72 ambulance calls consisting of the following: 61 medical, 11 trauma and 9 transfers; 2 nurse transfers, 1 canceled, 16 patient refusals, 3 standby, 0 codes, 0 DOAs, and 0 trauma team activation. 49 in-town calls and 23 out-of-town calls. 65 were Johnson county residents and 7 non-residents.

IV. KAYCEE REPORT:

1. Ambulance Calls

Michelle reported there were 17 calls in February: 8 trauma, 8 medical, 1 standby, 0 public assist, 6 refusals, 2 canceled, 0 Life Flight, 0 ALS Intercept. Michelle stated MS264 is scheduled to go to Greiner Ford for repairs for mechanical issues.

V. OLD BUSINESS:

1. Contract with Buffalo EMS

A letter to the RHCD Board regarding the contract negotiations between Buffalo EMS and RHCD was received. The letter dated March 4, 2020 is from Steven Freudenthal, attorney representing Buffalo EMS. Jim Hicks made a motion to attach the letter in the minutes for this meeting. Seconded by Bob McBride. Approved by all. There was discussion regarding contract

negotiations and meetings. The Board expressed they do not want Buffalo EMS meeting directly with Barry Crago regarding the contract. The RHCD held a work session March 5th to work on a proposed contract with Buffalo EMS. Barry Crago had not provided a revised draft of the contract to the RHCD Board. The contract was not available for discussion or review.

2. Ambulance Service RFP

Jim Hicks presented a draft of a Request for Proposal for Emergency Medical Services in case a contract is not agreed upon with Buffalo EMS. Bob McBride questioned the need for an RFP if the RHCD is currently negotiation a contract with Buffalo EMS. Jim asked the board members to review it for future consideration.

3. Tax Settlement

A letter from the Johnson County Commissioners dated February 19, 2020 was discussed. The letter advised of a tax settlement for tax years 2016, 2017, and 2018 with Carbon Creek Energy and Powder River Midstream. The RHCD should expect to receive \$58,694.04 in the settlement.

4. Bank RFP

A Request for Proposal was received from the Bank of Buffalo, ANB, First Northern Bank, and First Interstate Bank. The proposals were reviewed. Jim Hick made a motion to accept the proposal from the Bank of Buffalo and move the district's checking and money market accounts from First Interstate Bank to the Bank of Buffalo. Seconded by Mark Haines. Jim Hicks and Mark Haines voted aye. Bob McBride abstained. President Connolly voted aye. Karri was directed to open the accounts.

5. Collections

The assignment agreement with Collection Professionals Inc. was signed.

6. Nurse Transfers

Dave shared JCHC CEO Sean McCallister's thoughts regarding the JCHC pay for registered nurses on ground transports. The reasons listed included liability insurance coverage and financial means to pay. Dave explained the benefits of nurse transfers to both the patients and the District.

7. IRS

A document of Declaration of Representative was updated with the IRS.

8. Policies & By-Laws

The discussion was tabled as the Board has not received proposed changes from Barry Crago. Marilyn stressed the importance of adopting the policies as the Board was directed to do so in the FYE 2018 and 2019 audit.

1. Budget Timeline

Karri provided a RHCD budget timeline with preliminary figures to be provided at the April regular meeting. Jim Hicks stated he had emailed budget figures that he had prepared to the board members.

2. Write Off Request

Karri presented a write off request from a patient. Bob McBride made a motion to approve the write off request. Seconded by Mark Haines. Approved by all.

3. Meeting Time & Date

There was discussion to change the meeting time and date. Mark Haines made a motion to change the meeting day to the second Monday of the month at 4:00 p.m. in Buffalo and 5:00 p.m. when held in Kaycee. Jim Hicks seconded the motion. Jim Hicks and Mark Haines voted aye. Bob McBride voted nay. President Connolly voted aye.

4. Johnson County School Board

Marilyn reported she attended the Johnson County School Board meeting on March 9th requesting permission to research the feasibility of the School District's vacant land for a possible site for an ambulance barn. The School District granted the RHCD permission asking for an update by July 1, 2020.
