

#### Commissioner Meeting May 19, 2020

The regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was brought to order by Chairman William J. Novotny III, at 9:00am on Tuesday May 19, 2020. Attending were Commissioners Linda Greenough and Robert Perry, Commissioner's Assistant Sheila Newcomb, County Clerk Vicki Edelman and Deputy County Attorney Barry Crago. This meeting was held electronically via "Go to Meeting" for public access and participation.

Perry moved to approve the minutes of the May 5, 2020 regular meeting. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Scott Duncan Juvenile Probation Coordinator met with the Commissioners to give the VOA quarterly updates and review the contracts for renewal. After discussion Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the Agreement for 48-Hour Holdover Services & the Detention & Incarceration of Juvenile Offenders in the amount of \$2,000; the Agreement for Johnson County Court Supervised Treatment Program in the amount of \$38,773.30 and the Agreement between VOA and Johnson County for Juvenile Probation/Diversion Services in the amount of \$54,900; all three effective July 1, 2020 thru June 30, 2021 contingent upon final review by the County Attorney. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Perry moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the One Day Catering Permit to Taylor's Invasion Bar for the Rodriguez Wedding Reception May 23, 2020. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

After discussion with Emergency Manager Marilyn Connolly, Perry moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the Onsolve/Code Red Service Agreement in the amount of \$19,800 for a three-year period beginning May 21, 2020. Greenough seconded; motion carried.


