


Commissioner Meeting July 7, 2020

The regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was brought to order by Chairman William J Novotny III, at 9:00am on Tuesday July 7, 2020. Attending were Commissioners Linda Greenough and Robert Perry, Commissioner's Assistant Sheila Newcomb and County Clerk Vicki Edelman. This meeting was open to the public but held electronically via "Go to Meeting" for public access and participation as well.

Perry moved to approve the minutes of the June 15, 2020 regular meeting and the final bill pay meeting June 29, 2020. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to award the renewal scholarship to Nathan Kessler in the amount of \$500 per semester. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to designate a road named Youth Camp Road for the purpose of addressing only. Perry seconded; motion carried. The Commissioners restated this was for the purpose of addressing of the Youth Camp Road and it has not been designated a county road.

After Chairman Novotny opened the only fuel bid; Perry moved to accept the bid submitted by the Big Horn Coop for the 2020-2021 FY. Greenough seconded; motion carried. Other items discussed were paving on Hazelton Rd and work on the Youth Camp Rd.

Perry moved to ratify Resolution 637 which was signed June 17th to amend the partial fire restrictions. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to ratify Resolution 638, a resolution authorizing submission, by the Jim Gatchell Museum, an application for a TAP Grant which was signed June 29, 2020. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to ratify 2 catering permits which were signed June 19, 2020. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the Prevention Grant Agreement for a two- year period in the amount of \$221,548.00. Perry seconded; motion carried.

The Snider Ditch MOU was tabled until the next regular meeting.

After discussion, Greenough moved to sign the Resolution Authorizing Participation in the Wyoming CLASS. Perry seconded; motion carried. Chairman Novotny recused himself from discussion in this matter.

Perry moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the Victim Witness Grant for the 20-21FY in the amount of \$43,610. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Perry moved to approve the malt beverage permit to the Johnson County Fairgrounds Foundation for the Chancy Williams concert July 24, 2020. Greenough seconded. Motion carried.

Perry moved to approve the catering permits requested by Taylor's Invasion Bar for the Buffalo Night Rodeos at the Johnson County Fairgrounds July 8, 15, 22 and August 5, 12, 19 and 26, 2020. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to approve the catering permits requested by Taylor's Invasion Bar for July 11, 2020 for the Matt Ehler's wedding reception at Lakeview Lodge 307 and the Beth Besel wedding reception July 25, 2020 at 802 Birch St. Perry seconded; motion carried.


Greenough moved to reject the offer on the airport property. Perry seconded; motion carried.


Greenough moved to go into executive session regarding personnel at 9:55am. Perry seconded; motion carried.
