

Commissioner Meeting June 2, 2020

The regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was brought to order by Chairman William J Novotny III, at 9:00am on Tuesday June 2, 2020. Attending were Commissioners Linda Greenough and Robert Perry, Commissioner's Assistant Sheila Newcomb and County Clerk Vicki Edelman. This meeting was open to the public but held electronically via "Go to Meeting" for public access and participation as well.

Perry moved to approve the minutes of the May 19, 2020 regular meeting. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

After discussion with Prevention Coordinator Bill Hawley, Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the 2-year Prevention Grant Program Application in the amount of \$221,548.00. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to re-appoint William McIntyre and to appoint Jennifer Bakken to the Library Board for 3-year terms. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Perry moved to re-appoint George Korhel to the Mountain Plains Heritage Park Board for a 2-year term. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to re-appoint George Shafer to the Northern Wy Mental Health Board for a 4-year term. Perry seconded; motion carried.


