
Perry moved to appoint David Iverson for a 3-year term to the Solid Waste District Board. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Commissioner Meeting February 2, 2021

The regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was brought to order by Vice-Chairman, Linda Greenough at 9:00am on Tuesday February 2, 2021. Attending were Commissioners Linda Greenough and Robert Perry, Commissioner's Assistant Sheila Newcomb, County Attorney Tucker Ruby and County Clerk Vicki Edelman. This meeting was held electronically via "Go to Meeting" for public access and participation.

Clerk of District Court Paige Rhoads; Sheriff Rod Odenbach and Undersheriff Pat Monroe met with the Commissioners to give their year in review presentations.

Perry moved to approve the minutes of the January 19, 2021 regular meeting. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Scott Duncan with VOA met with the Commissioners to give his quarterly updates.

County Attorney Tucker Ruby, Planner Jim Waller, Facilities Manager David Eads, Emergency Manager Marilyn Connolly and County Clerk Vicki Edelman met with the Commissioners to give their year in review presentations.

Chairman Novotny called the Hearing for Liquor License renewal to order. Perry moved to approve the renewal of all Johnson County Liquor Licenses for the 2021-22 year. Greenough seconded; motion carried. Johnson County has (7) retail liquor licenses: Cowboy Saloon of Buffalo, Folded Hills Ranch, Good 2 Go Store #13, The Winchester Steakhouse, The Lake Stop, Paradise Guest Ranch, South Fork Resort; (1) resort license: HF Bar Ranch; (1) fraternal club license: Johnson County Moose 2675; and (1) restaurant license: TA Guest Ranch.

Chairman Novotny called the budget hearing to order. Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign Resolution #653, a resolution to amend the FY20-21 budget in the amount of \$60,254.00. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Perry moved to approve the quarterly legal expenses in the amount of \$38,326.28 which will be split among the districts as well as the county. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Chairman Novotny outlined the time frame for interviews and hire of the new Commissioner's Assistant. After discussion Perry moved to lift the hiring freeze and allow the Commissioners to replace the assistant position. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Other items discussed were new HLS grants, Bomber Mtn MOU and new plans which Marilyn Connolly is working on. Bill Osteimer from the Recycle Board met with the Commissioners to discuss the board appointments.

Greenough moved to approve the vouchers for January in the amount of \$430,808.95. Perry seconded; motion carried.
