Minutes

May 10, 2021

The regular monthly meeting of the Johnson County Rural Health Care District was held at the County Planning Office on Monday, May 10, 2021. The meeting began at 4:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by President Marilyn Connolly. Present were Marilyn Connolly, Jim Hicks, Mark Haines, Marie Miller, Scott McBride, Crosby Taylor, Logan Williamson, Mark Bentley, Dennis Thorson, Barry Crago, Dave Harness and Karri White. A quorum was present. The agenda was approved as submitted.

I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF LAST MEETING:

The motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting on April 12, 2021 was made by Marie Miller and seconded by Jim Hicks. Approved by all.

II. VIEW AND APPROVE TREASURER'S REPORT:

Jim Hicks presented the April Treasurer's Report for review. Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report was made by Mark Haines and seconded by Scott McBride. Approved by all.

III. BUFFALO REPORT:

1. Ambulance Calls

Karri White reported April had 57 ambulance calls consisting of the following: 43 medical, 14 trauma and 16 transfers; 4 nurse transfers, 2 canceled, 8 patient refusals, 1 standby, 0 codes, 1 DOA, and 1 trauma team activation. 24 in-town calls and 33 out-of-town calls. 47 were Johnson county residents and 10 non-residents. Karri mentioned MS106 is going to be checked for a possible cv joint replacement.

IV. KAYCEE REPORT:

1. Ambulance Calls

Crosby reported there were 6 total calls in April: 1 trauma, 5 medical, 0 standby, 0 public assist, 1 refusal, 0 canceled, 0 Life Flight, 0 ALS Intercept, 6 total patients. Crosby reported MS264 has a leaky oil pan and will need to go in for repairs.

V. OLD BUSINESS:

1. 2021/2022 Budget

Marilyn stated she received a letter from Buffalo EMS on April 23, 2021 accepting the 2021/2022 contract amount of \$750,000. The FYE 2022 budget was discussed. Mark Haines made a motion to approve the proposed budget with total expenses of \$1,350,565. Seconded by Scott McBride. Approved by all. Karri will provide the figures to Cloud Peak Accounting to complete the Budget Summary Form to be submitted to the County Commissioners and State by June 1st.

2. Airport Repeater

Marilyn met Chesbro Electric at the airport repeater building. The equipment box was not plugged in to the electrical outlet but was connected to the battery.

3. Ambulance Remount

Karri provided two quotes to remount the MS106 box on a new chassis. The board requested Karri secure one more bid and present them at the next regular meeting.

Call for old business:

4. Standby Policy

Mark Haines wants to revisit the standby policy. Jim Hicks stated the board will discuss the policy prior to next year's budget session and to continue with asking for a donation to Buffalo EMS for Buffalo standbys apart from the school district football games.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

1. Executive Session

Jim Hicks made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss real estate matters at 5:00 p.m. Seconded by Mark Haines. Approved by all.

At 5:35 p.m. the Executive Session adjourned.

At 5:37 p.m. the Regular Meeting reconvened.

Jim Hicks moved to make an offer for a parcel of land owned by Fire District #1 in the amount of \$80,000. Motion was seconded by Mark Haines.

During a discussion following the motion, Dave Harness, owner of Buffalo EMS, LLC, voiced several objections that included him not being involved earlier, that the location was a poor choice and that spending in this area was not wise durn an economic decline.

Following the discussion the board voted to pass the motion. Voting in favor were Jim Hicks and Mark Haines. Voting "no" were Scott McBride and Marie Miller. Chairman Marilyn Connolly voted aye to break the tie. Motion passed.

Call for new business:

Vouchers were initialed, and checks signed by the board members. Report attached. Jim Hicks made a motion to approve the vouchers. Seconded by Mark Haines. Approved by all. There being no further new business, Scott McBride made a motion to adjourn the regular meeting at 5:55 p.m. Seconded by Mark Haines. Motion carried.

The next regular meeting will be held on Monday, June 14, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. at the County Planning Office, Buffalo, Wyoming.

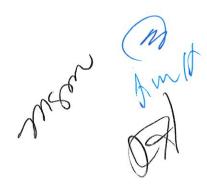
