


Commissioner Meeting July 6, 2021

The regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was brought to order by Chairman William J. Novotny, III at 9:00am on Tuesday July 6, 2021. Attending were Commissioners Linda Greenough and Robert Perry, Commissioner's Assistant Ashlea Bassett, County Attorney Tucker Ruby and County Clerk Vicki Edelman.

Greenough moved to approve the minutes of the June 15, 2021 regular meeting. Novotny seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign Resolution #663, a resolution to amend the FY2021 budget, correcting deficit budgets. Novotny seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to approve the transfer of the Lake Stop, LLC liquor license to Lake Stop Resort, LLC and authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the new license. Novotny seconded; motion carried.

Perry moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign Resolution #662, a Partial Fire Restriction in Johnson County and rescinding Resolution # 661. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

After discussion Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign Resolution #664, a resolution removing the probation period for Fairboard employees to be on the employee health insurance plan, at the request of the Fairboard. Perry seconded; motion carried. County Attorney Tucker Ruby will draft the resolution for signature.

Heath Steele, Susan Arnold, Scott Duncan and County Attorney Tucker Ruby met with the Commissioners for final discussion on the pending contracts with Volunteers of America. After discussion of the 17 year relationship between VOA and Johnson County; Greenough moved to amend the 48 hour contract to remove the 24 hour on call for one year; to amend the diversion contract and drug court contract to terminate effective September 30, 2021. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Mechelle Rivera, Public Health Nurse Manager was introduced to the Commissioners by Melissa Ohnstead.

Perry moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the drug court contract between Wyoming Dept of Health & Johnson County in the amount of \$48, 193.05 for one year beginning July 1, 2021. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the Contract for Services between Johnson County and St Francis Animal Shelter in the amount of \$3,600.00 for one year. Perry seconded; motion carried.

After discussion and at the request of Commissioner Perry; Perry moved to bring the Harold Jarrard Park Dept back in house and terminate the contract with the Town of Kaycee. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign the amended contract between the State Dept of Corrections and Johnson County. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Commissioner Perry asked that the discussion on increases in the hangar leases be moved to the next regular meeting.

Greenough moved to approve the renewal commissioner's scholarships to Jade Maya and alternate Elsa Freise for the 21-22 year. Perry seconded; motion carried.




Perry moved to go into Executive Session regarding potential litigation. Greenough seconded; motion carried. The regular meeting resumed at 11:06am.

Greenough moved to approve the minutes of the special bill pay meeting June 28, 2021. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Chairman Novotny called for the Budget Hearing at 9:03am.

Greenough moved to approve the budget amounts for the Johnson County Fair, budget \$300,000 Mil 1.213; Jim Gatchell Museum, budget \$168,000 Mil .680; Johnson County Library budget \$380,815.32 Mil 1.540. Perry seconded; motion carried.

Perry moved to approve the Special District Mil Levies for the FY21-22 as presented: Cemetery Dist. 1Mil; Clear Creek Conservation Dist. 1Mil; JC Hospital Dist. 3Mil; JC Fire District #1 3Mil; JC Solid Waste Dist. 1Mil; Powder River Conservation Dist. 1Mil; Powder River Fire Dist. 3Mil; Rural Health Care Dist. 2Mil; Senior Center Service Dist. 1Mil; JC Weed & Pest 1Mil; JC Weed & Pest Leafy Spurge 1Mil. Greenough seconded; motion carried.

Greenough moved to authorize Chairman Novotny to sign Resolution #665, a resolution to transfer funds for FY21-22. Perry seconded; motion carried.
