1. EWP Projects

2. State Forestry Project Update

The crew will be moving to Inchauspe's tomorrow. There are still 147.5 acres to finish and should be done by the end of August. The first payment for the project was included in this month's bills. The remainder will be paid out when the project is complete, and State Forestry has certified the project.

3. Well Water Testing Day
