#### Johnson County Rural Health Care District

#### Minutes

#### October 11, 2021

The regular monthly meeting of the Johnson County Rural Health Care District was held at the County Planning Office on Monday, October 11, 2021. The meeting began at 4:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by President Marilyn Connolly. Present were Marilyn Connolly, Scott McBride, Jim Hicks, Dr. Mark Schueler, Commissioner Bill Novotny, Seth Taylor, Dennis Thorson, Carolyn Fox, Mark Bentley, Dave Harness and Karri White. Mark Haines, Crosby Taylor, and Barry Crago were present via phone conference. A quorum was present.

**AGENDA:** Jim Hicks moved to approve the agenda with the addition of CMS Cost Survey and Land Survey. Seconded by Mark Haines. Approved by all present.

**VOUCHERS:** October vouchers were reviewed. Scott McBride moved to approve the vouchers. Seconded by Jim Hicks. Approved by all present. Jim Hicks voiced concerns about the process used to approve vouchers for payroll and health insurance for Buffalo EMS in the past and asked Karri White and Dave Harness to address his questions.

#### I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF LAST MEETINGS:

Jim Hicks moved to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting on September 13, 2021 with one correction. Seconded by Scott McBride. Approved by all.

#### II. VIEW AND APPROVE TREASURER'S REPORT:

Jim Hicks presented the September Treasurer's Report for review. A motion to approve the Treasurer's Report was made by Scott McBride and seconded by Mark Haines. Approved by all present.

#### III. BUFFALO REPORT:

#### 1. Ambulance Calls

Dave Harness reported September had 66 ambulance calls consisting of the following: 62 medical, 4 trauma and 9 transfers; 3 nurse transfers, 2 canceled, 17 patient refusals, 9 standby, 0 code, 2 DOAs, 0 extrication and 0 trauma team activations. 44 in-town calls and 22 out-of-town calls. 52 were Johnson County residents and 14 non-residents.

#### IV. KAYCEE REPORT:

#### 1. Ambulance Calls

Crosby reported there were 22 calls in September: 8 trauma, 11 medical, 2 standby, 1 transfer, 5 refusals, 1 canceled, 1 Life Flight, 0 ALS Intercept, 16 total patients.

#### V. OLD BUSINESS:

#### 1. NCSR - Cybersecurity

DigeTekS will complete the cybersecurity review for the RHCD.

#### 2. CMS – Cost Data Collection

Marilyn mentioned the RHCD was originally selected to complete the Cost Data Collection and chose to report fiscal year rather than calendar year but was unsure when the information is required.

#### 3. Land Survey

Nelson Engineering submitted a survey of the land that has been proposed to purchase from the Johnson County Fire District was presented along with an invoice for services.

#### VI. NEW BUSINESS

#### 1. Grant Assistance Agreement

Marilyn Connolly presented a contract agreement between the RHCD and Toni Cervenka to write grants on behalf of the RHCD to buy land and construct a modern Ambulance Station. The board agreed there was a need for a long-range strategic plan. Jim Hicks made a motion to accept the agreement. Seconded by Mark Haines. Jim Hicks and Mark Haines voted aye. Scott McBride voted nay. Motion passed.

#### 2. Dr. Schueler

Dr. Schueler was asked by Marilyn Connolly if he would support a Paramedic service in Kaycee. He said no and provided reasons such as proficiency and pain medication issues. He said the case volume is too low to guarantee proficiency and it could be more harmful than helpful. The liability of that along with carrying and administering drugs such as fentanyl is a concern. He stated the liability and expense might not offset the benefit and suggested an analysis should be done before deciding which pain medications to carry.

#### Call for new business:

#### 3. Strategic Planning

Chairman Connolly reported she and Jim had traveled to Gillette to meet with the ambulance director for Campbell County Health (CCH) to learn how their operations work in Gillette, Wright and Newcastle. They both said they had some issues with the idea of CCH providing services in Johnson County. CCH is providing Paramedic level services in all three communities.

Chairman Connolly asked for public comment.

Dennis Thorson stated that after a year of observing the RHCD meetings he feels there is a board member that is a bully and is not respectful to other board members or those attending the meetings.

Jim Hicks moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:43 p.m. Seconded by Scott McBride. Approved by all.
