The March 7, 2022 meeting of the Johnson County Senior Citizens Services Special District Meeting was called to order at 4:00 PM by President Mark Wilson.

Mr. Gay moved to approve the minutes of the February 7, 2022 meeting. Ms. Fraley seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Ms. Fraley gave the treasurer's report. Current balance is \$199,746.59. Ms. Benner moved and Mr. Gay seconded to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Benner reported that the bylaws have been amended to allow officers to hold their office for 2 years. The amended bylaws have been forwarded to the board and the attorney for review. The attorney should be present at the April meeting so the board can vote on the changes.


The upcoming election in August for the continuation of the mill for the Senior Citizen Service District was discussed. The question for the ballot would need to be to the Clerk by June 1. The assessor estimates revenues should be up by at least 10% this fiscal year. The consensus of the group was to not request a change to two mills at this election.

Mr. Mock updated the board on the upcoming legislative session and bills that may impact state funding for senior services.


There were no board comments
