BILLS:

Bills in the amount of \$236,294.37 were reviewed and approved for payment.

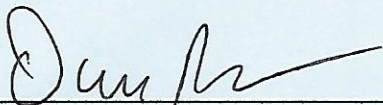
MINUTES:

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mr. Fox updated the board on the operation of the landfill.
 - Turbo went out on the 524K loader. It was fixed by landfill personnel and is running.
 - AC work done on the 963D. We also had 2 hydraulic leaks which caused us to use all the Hydraulic oil we had and another drum has been purchased.
 - The cheapest alternative to the rock that was discovered during digging the new phases was to use it as a ramp as access to the bottom. To remove the rock, it was bid at \$142,000. To build a ramp was \$8400. We will lose 2/3 of a year's garbage space due to the ramp having to be left in.
 - The new CD pit is complete along with all soil removal. We are on standby till the liner is delivered.
 - The Audit has started
 - Bob Fox is hoping to attend an investment seminar Friday the 15th of July

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 4:35 p.m.
