<u>Election of Officers</u>: Steve Haines opened the floor for nominations for the three positions of the board. Matt Carr moved to nominate Steve Haines as chairman, Steve Haines seconded the motion. *Vote: 2 ayes. Motion Carried.*

Steve Haines moved to nominate Matt Carr as secretary, Matt Carr seconded the motion. *Vote:* 2 ayes. *Motion Carried.*

Matt Carr moved to nominate Kevin Lund as treasurer, Steve Haines seconded the motion.

Vote: 2 ayes. Motion Carried.

Becky Schiermiester was instructed to make the necessary arrangements to add Matt Carr to the signature cards, as well as removing Fred Carr from the same accounts.

<u>Minutes</u>: Matt Carr moved to approve the minutes for the regular board meeting held on November 9th, 2022, as presented. Steve Haines seconded the motion. *Vote: 2 ayes. Motion Carried.*

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Becky Schiermiester presented the board with an income/expense report, a balance sheet, and a progressive budget report for December. Chief Richardson and the board discussed the percentage of the budget that has already been expensed and brainstorming ideas to start setting aside reserves to replace outdated and aging equipment/radios next fiscal year. Matt Carr moved to accept the treasurer's reports, seconded by Steve Haines. *Vote: 2 ayes. Motion Carried.*

Fire Chief's Report:

<u>Call Outs</u>: Fire Chief Kenneth Richardson reported that the district had four incidents during the past month. The district responded to one vehicle fire, one false alarm call, one motor vehicle assist (ambulance assist), and one training.

<u>Emergency Communications Board Meeting</u>: Chief Richardson reported that he attended the emergency communications meeting. The chief stated that monies to repair/replace repeaters will need to be budgeted for in the next fiscal year budget.

<u>VFA Grant</u>: Chief Richardson reported that the VFA grant that he applied for was approved. The money will be used to purchase new radios and pagers.

The board and the chief discussed other grants that maybe accepting applications.

Old Business:

<u>Wyoming Rural Fire Meeting</u>: Chief Richardson stated that he was unable to attend the Wyoming Rural Fire meeting.

New Business:
