The NWMHC COVID-19 Response Plan as of 3/20/2020 is as follows:

- We are actively reaching out to all clients to offer support and determine the best way to provide services.
- We are rapidly and aggressively moving toward the provision of extensive telehealth services; to be implemented within the next week.
- We are still providing services to clients including injections, weekly pill box fills, and crisis services.
- We have suspended all in-office and face-to-face services through 4/3/2020. We are making exceptions for crises/emergencies where need dictates.
- We will re-evaluate the COVID-19 Response Plan prior to 4/3/2020.

On-call services are still in place and available 24/7.
