After much discussion and with an abundance of caution the Buffalo Senior Center building will remain closed through the month of June. Home delivered meals will still be available. No activities (pool, support groups, cards, etc.) will be scheduled, and no in-house lunches will be served in the dining room.

Starting Monday, June 1, 8 a.m. the Buffalo Area Transportation System will begin operating on a limited basis.

**Certain guidelines will be followed.**

Rides will be available for drive-thru businesses only (banks, pharmacies, and drive thru restaurants). Grocery stores, Family Dollar and other businesses are not applicable.

Only one (1) passenger will be transported at a time. ALL riders MUST wear masks. The drivers will also be required to wear masks. After each passenger, the vans will be sanitized. You must call (684-9551) at least 24 hours in advance to schedule your rides.

Rides to medical appointments will still be offered.

Grocery pick up at DJ's and IGA will continue with adherence to already in-place procedures. Bread of Life Food Pantry orders can still be picked up and delivered. Both of these services are offered to our seniors age 60 or over.

The Finders Keepers Thrift Store will open for business Tuesday, June 2 at 10 a.m.

The guidelines to shop are as follows.

Only 10 customers in the store at one time.

Customers are required to wear masks.

Customers must use hand sanitizer prior to entering the store.

The Finders Keepers Thrift Store is a project of the Buffalo Senior Center. All proceeds from sales go to support and expand the center's programs. No federal, state, or local tax or grant money is used in the store's operation.
