COVID-19 Vaccinations Progressing

Johnson County is giving all doses of the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine as it becomes available weekly. Both pharmacies; Prescription Shop and Corner Stone Pharmacy, will now be offering vaccinations to those 65 and older. If you are eligible, please give them a call to schedule.

Johnson County Public Health is beginning to schedule K-12 education (teachers and staff), and child care services.

For those 65 and older, the Wyoming Department of Health has created a pre-registration form online:

Johnson County Public Health will be receiving this information, and will be passing along to the pharmacies.

Vaccine Reminders:

- Side effects are expected after the Moderna vaccination. This is your body's way of building immunity to COVID-19.
- Please bring your insurance card and ID to your appointment. There is NO CHARGE for the vaccination to you, but the provider may bill insurance for the administration fee of the vaccine.
- Those vaccinated still need to wear a face covering, social distance, and practice good hand hygiene.

- Don't forget to show up at your scheduled appointment for your second dose. We are requesting you receive your second dose from the same provider who gave your first vaccination, **to ensure the second dose is available**. The second dose is important to acquire the 94% effective rate.

Johnson County has no positive COVID-19 cases! Please continue all of your efforts to keep COVID-19 cases down in our county.
