Vaccination Update

Johnson County vaccination efforts has made great progress! We are excited to announce that we are moving into Phase 2 for COVID-19 vaccinations. This phase is open to **all** Johnson County residents, 18 and older as per authorization of the Moderna and Johnson and Johnson vaccine!

Johnson County Healthcare Center now has the Johnson and Johnson (Janssen) vaccine, which is only one dose. Johnson County Public Health, Corner Stone Pharmacy, Buffalo Prescription Shop, and Big Horn Pediatrics & Family Medicine have the Moderna vaccine, which is 2 doses, separated by 28 days.

COVID-19 still in Johnson County

As of today, there is 1 active COVID-19 case in Johnson County. Residents are urged to stay the course of masking, social distancing and proper hand hygiene to

avoid the spread of COVID-19 in our community. If you feel you may have symptoms of COVID-19 please continue to see the providers in our community for testing.

Vaccine Reminders:

- Side effects are expected after the Moderna vaccination. This is your body's way of building immunity to COVID-19.
- Please bring your insurance card and ID to your appointment. There is NO CHARGE for the vaccination to you, but the provider may bill insurance for the administration fee of the vaccine.
- Those vaccinated still need to wear a face covering, social distance, and practice good hand hygiene.
- Don't forget to show up at your scheduled appointment for your second dose. We are requesting you receive your second dose from the same provider who gave your first vaccination, **to ensure the second dose is available**. The second dose is important to acquire the 94% effective rate.
- Please be aware of where you are receiving vaccine information.
